
Culturally Responsive Pedagogy

When did CRT start

• CRT was introduced by Gloria Ladson Billings in 1990s. She noticed the biasness with black children and their families for two years. To provide equal status and respect to students she develop the framework of culturally responsive pedagogy.

In 2000 Gay introduced other powerful tools for classroom diversity known as Culturally Relevant pedagogies and culturally sustaining teaching.

Culturally relevant curricula

Different communication styles

Culturally sustaining teaching includes

Valuing community languages and practices

Student and community agency and input

- CRT allows teachers to make assessments that enhance students equity and value of students. There are three interrelated purpose of assessment.
- Assessment in learning: contain all the information of student which assist students Development. It include in all teaching methodology. Teacher provides instructions and feedback to enhance performance.
- Assessment as learning:- It involve students action learning ,tracking their own growth with the assistance of teacher. It occur through out the learning process.
- Assessment for learning:- Teacher use results of student knowledge and learning practices to make judgement about student achievement.

- It provides opportunity to report evidence of achievement
- It occur at the end of course.
- It provides foundation for placement and promotion of students.


How to put culturally responsive Teaching into practice
