Name Card Introduction Activity

Materials: Blank cue cards (if possible ones without lines, if not then use the back side). Students preferred drawing materials (pens, pencil crayons, markers, etc.).

Directions/Activity Itself:

Please note that teachers should create their own name card prior to the activity.

- 1) Start by introducing yourself with your own name card.
- 2) Hand blank cue cards out to the students.
- 3) Students will first write their name in the centre of the cue card.
- 4) Then students will draw around their name images of things that are important to them, whether that is their interests, hobbies, pets, family, favourite foods etc. Give students about 5-10 minutes to do this.
- 5) Walk around, glimpse at names, ask students what they are drawing.
- 6) After the time is up, have students introduce themselves by saying their name and describing their name card.
