When individuals share common goals and each individual's outcomes are affected by the actions of the others

Resources

The raw materials or component parts of a finished product that may include natural resources, human resources, and capital resources (equipment and buildings)

Culture

A learned way of living, including language, beliefs, arts, sports, and food, that is shared by a group of people
