I want to acknowledge that we are on Treaty 4 Territory the original land of the Cree, Saulteaux, Dakota, Nakota, Lakota and the homeland of the Metis Nation. I believe it is important to have this acknowledgement to honor and respect those that came before us, shaping our land. I am a white settler but will always pay my respects to those that began living on this land. I will mention that it's important to never forget the pain and suffering so many Indigenous people have been through. We, as a nation, as a community, must work together to make a change and support those that need our help. It is easy to forget something that didn't directly affect us, but it still does not undermine the horrific events that happened. As a future teacher, I will ensure that I honor and spread my knowledge about Indigenous history, and always relearn and unlearn, while helping others start their journey.
