Indigenous Content:
<u>Classroom Management</u>
 Student groups: One student will be chosen as helper and get to sit in the rocking chair. All other students will sit down on the rug in a half circle facing teacher and helper.

Step 1 - Desired Results
Language/Literacy - Working on language/literacy by counting the numbers on the calendar (number recognition). The numbers on the calendar are in patterns, helper will identify what the new numbers image will be in regard to the pattern. Working on making connections to the number and words by having a picture (visual). Teacher will read a book to the students.

Step 3 - Learning Plan
<u>Learning activities</u> (step by step from start to finish, detailed enough for another teacher to follow)
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. After students finish tabletop activity they will put away their stuff and go sit on the rug for table time.2. Teacher will chose the Helper from the front of the envelope.3. Helper will get to sit in the small rocking chair.4. Helper will say hello to everyone.5. Helper will get to use the pointer to count the dates on the calendar.6. Class will say the number on the calendar as a group when the helper points to it.7. Teacher will see if students know what todays day is before showing the number.8. Teacher will ask the helper if they can guess what the new image of the day is based on the pattern. (Ex. TRex, Triceratops, stegosaurus, Pterodactyl, repeat)9. Teacher will read the book Ten Tiny Dinosaurs. Book counting dinosaurs, engage students too count how many dinosaurs there are per page before moving on. Ask them what they see.

- Book - Ten Tiny Dinosaurs by Clare Fennell
- Calendar by teachers reading chair.
- Numbers for calendar (images have different dinosaurs on them, used in a pattern)
- Small rocking chair, for helper
- Pointer for helper
