Stage 1: Identify Desired Results

Outcome(s):

Core French - pronunciation, Christmas theme.

Key Understandings: ('I Can' statements)

- Review how to say the words before switching to each new question.

Pictionary

5 min

Explain the rules

- 2 teams, half the class. Each team provides one artist per
- The two people must come to the teacher and find out what Christmas vocabulary they will draw.
- The students will get 90 seconds to draw 2 items. Each team gets a different item to draw. The students must guess.
- After 60 seconds, if the students don't know, they can search on the computer until the 90 second mark is up.
- Points awarded 1 per correct guess. Bonus: 1 if someone (different each time) can use one of the words in a french sentence correctly.
- 1 point will be deducted if the teacher hears English during each guessing period.

Play game

20 min

Keep track of score on the board and encourage the students throughout.

Watch out for cheating and english.
